



Court halts NTT from selling stake in Sri Lanka Telecom

The Supreme Court in Sri Lanka has stopped Japan-based **Nippon Telegraph & Telephone** from selling its stake in Sri Lanka Telecom, which is the island's main telecom company. Last month, NTT reached an accord to sell 25.3% of its 35.2% stake in Sri Lanka Telecom to Global Telecom Holdings, but a petition alleging corruption in the deal led to the Supreme Court's decision.
