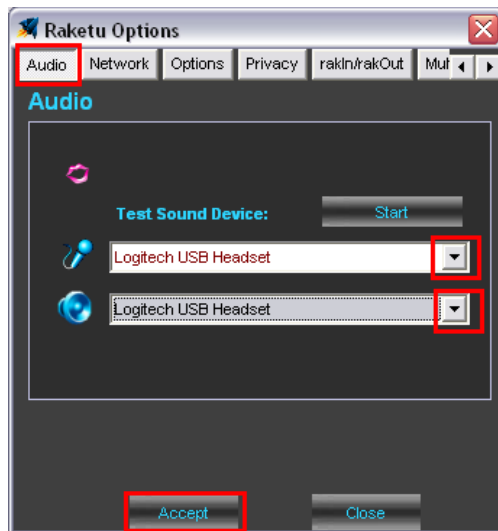
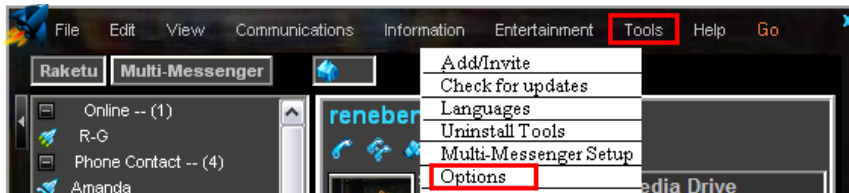


# How to setup Audio in Raketu – Win XP

The first time you install Raketu you have to setup the audio.

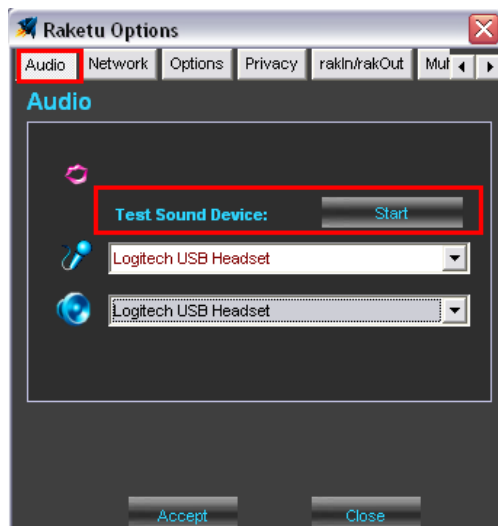
## a) Set up microphone and speakers.

In Raketu program go to **Tools -> Options -> Audio**. Click on the drop down menu and select the desired microphone and speaker to be used in RakOut service. Make sure to click the "Accept" button to apply the changes.

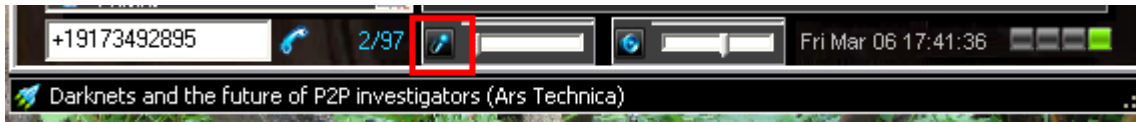


## b) Test your microphone and speakers.

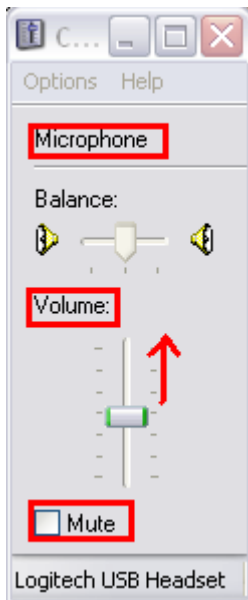
Go to Tools -> Options -> Audio. Click on the "Start" button next to the sentence "**Test your sound device**". Speak to the microphone and you will hear yourself in your speakers or headsets. This confirms that your sound has been setup correctly. Now just click on the "Stop" button to stop sound test.



c) To quickly access your main/windows microphone slider, just click on the microphone icon located in the bottom of the Raketu program see below.



By Clicking on the microphone, the main volume controller for microphone will open.



Make sure it is not on mute and also raise the volume of the microphone slider to higher level.

**Make sure you did not mute the mic or the speakers. Blue icon mean the sound is ON**



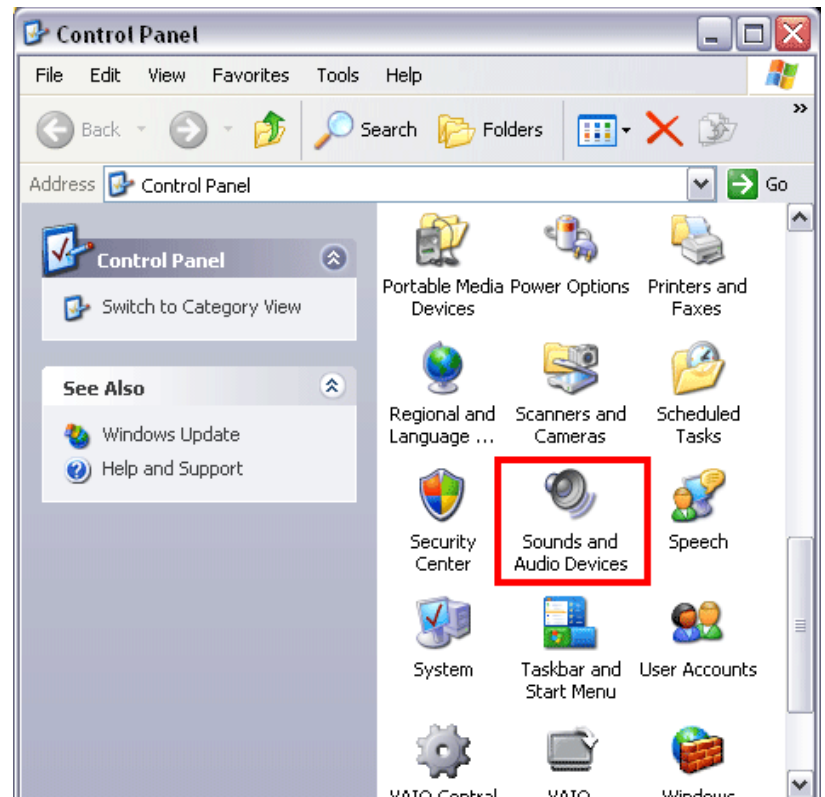
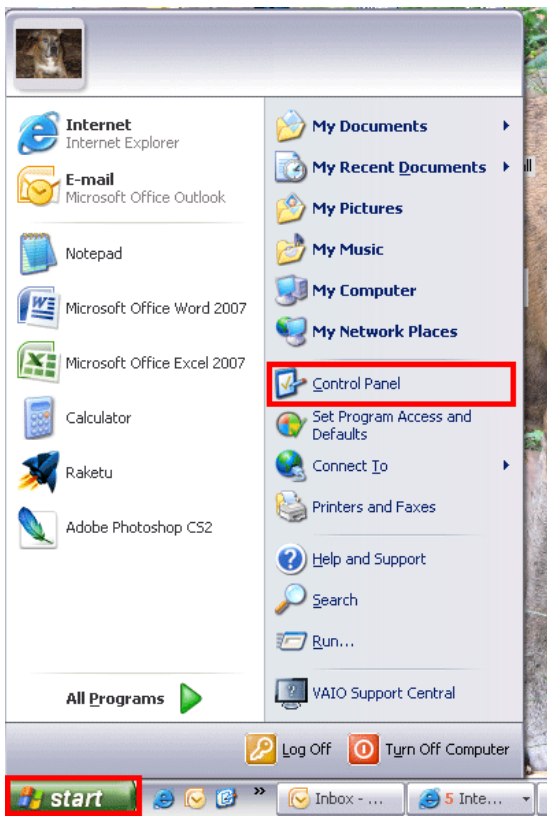
If you make the sound mute the icon will change color to gray. Gray icon means **MUTE**.

Make sure your sound devices are **ON** in Raketu program (icons must be blue). To turn it on or off, just click on the icon.



If you still have a problems with the audio in Raketu, make sure you did check audio setup in windows!

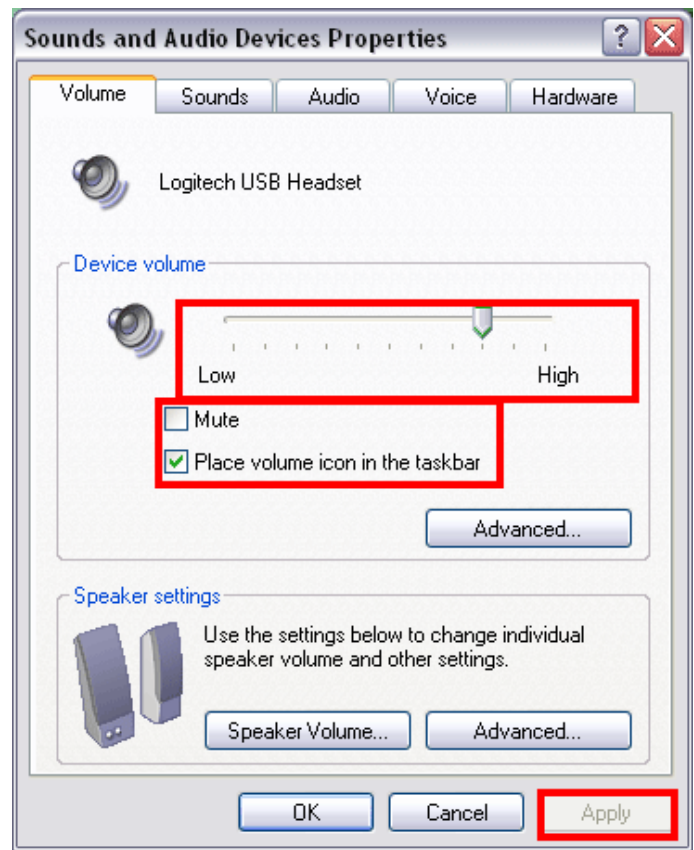
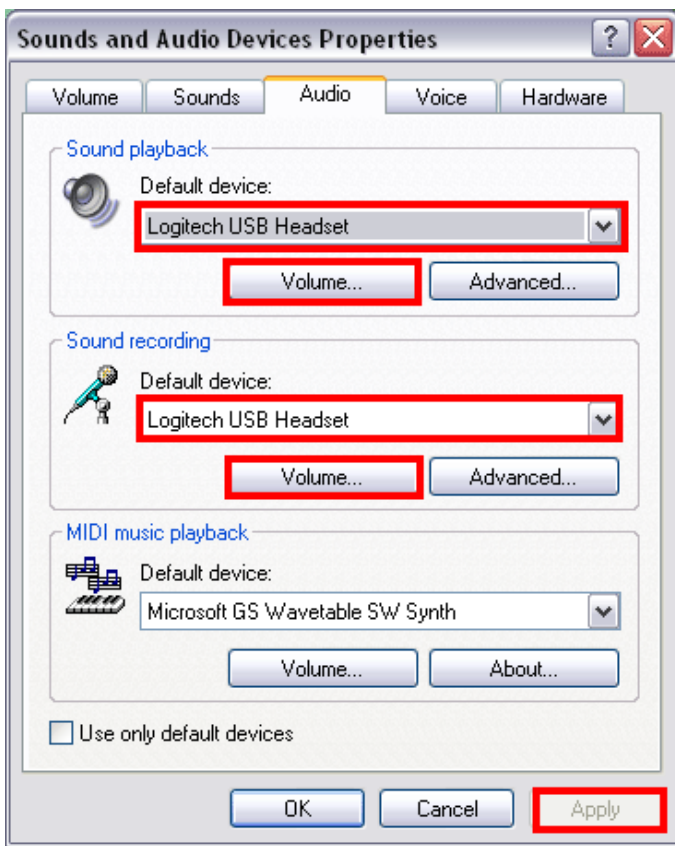
1. Click on **START-Control Panel** -> **Sounds and Audio devices** -> click on **Audio** tab.



2. Make sure you have a correct device selected in this "recording section" You can choose device for microphone from drop down menu. Then click on "apply" to save the changes. Click on Volume and

make sure the microphone is NOT in mute mode. Click on the volume and if you have more than one microphone choice, in the bottom of the microphone volume window, make sure you have selected the microphone and not line or any other device. Make sure you are NOT in mute mode. See the next page pictures

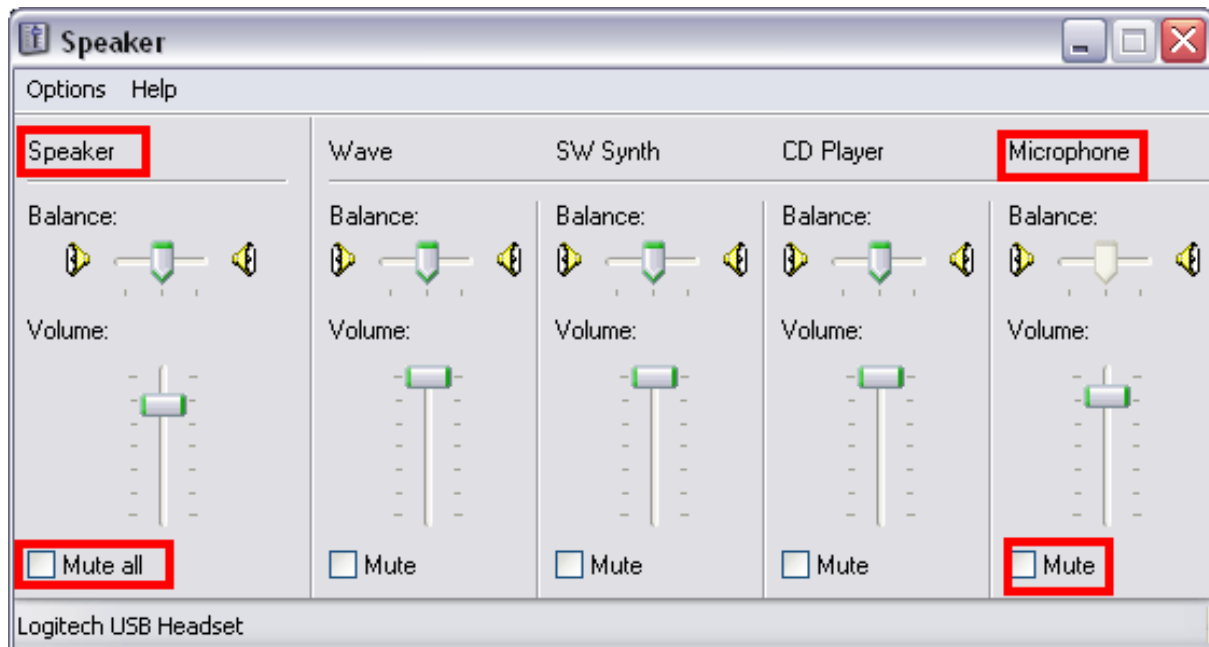
Click on the „Volume“ tab, make sure volume is NOT on mute, and the slider is set closed to high. If you make any changes always click on the „apply“ button. You can place the volume icon on the task bar



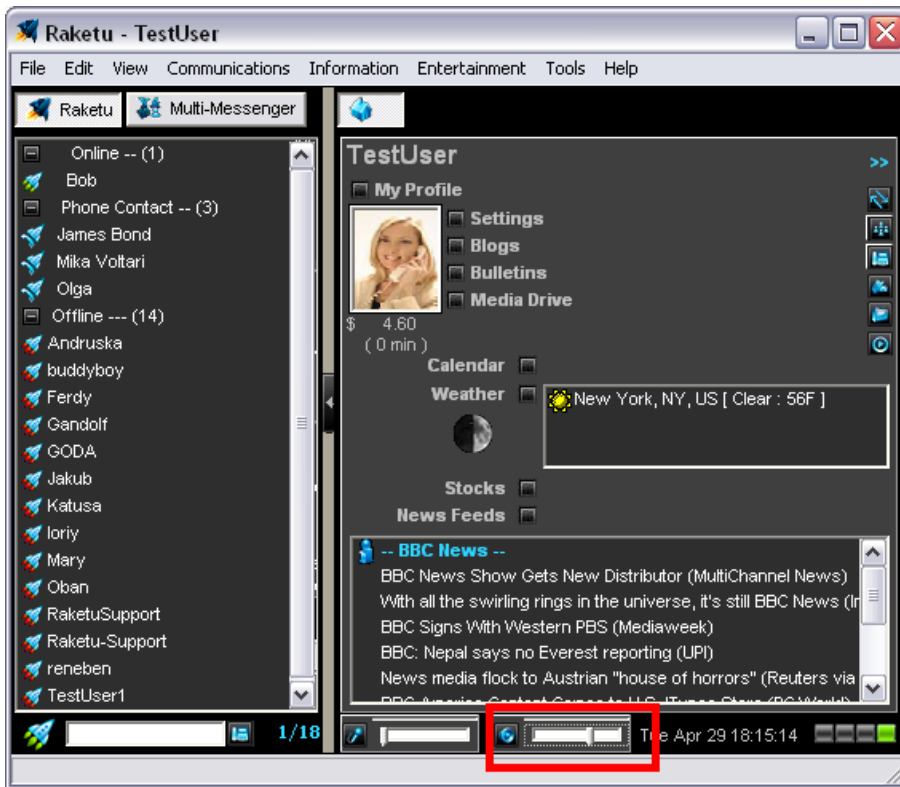
## On the Task Bar



If you double click on the speaker icon in the task bar a volume control panel will open. Make sure Mute button is UNCHECKED and the slider is on high, see the picture below.



Make also sure that the slider is on high in Raketu program. If you are using USB headsets you will not be able to regulate the volume of the microphone from Raketu, because windows take over. So the microphone volume needs to be adjusted for the mail volume control in windows like the picture above.



To quickly access your main/windows microphone slider, just click on the microphone icon located in the bottom of the Raketu program.
