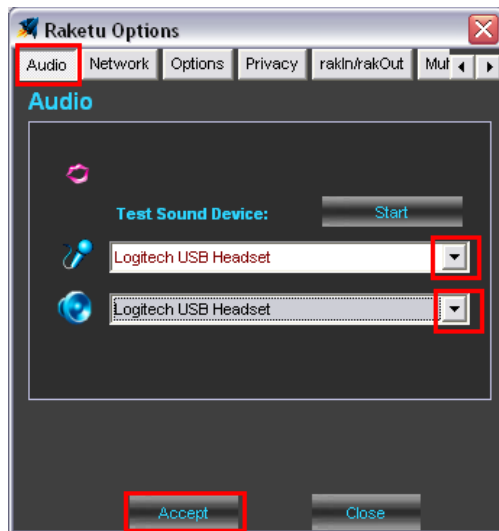
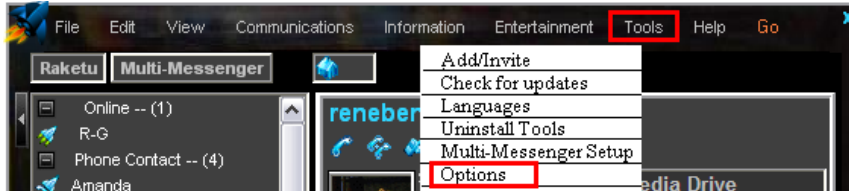


How to setup Audio in Raketu – Win Vista

The first time you install Raketu you have to setup the audio.

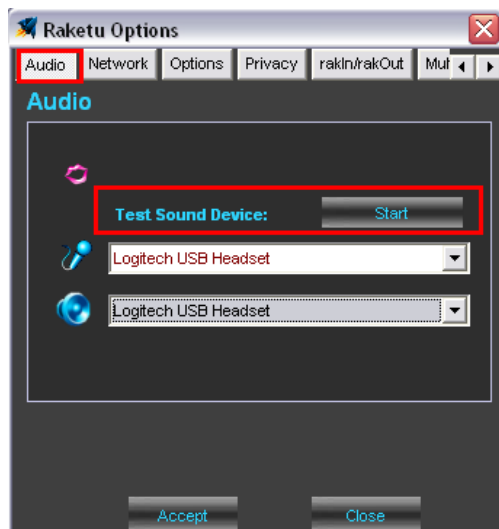
a) Set up microphone and speakers.

Go to Tools -> Options -> Audio. Click on the drop down menu and select the desired microphone and speaker to be used in RakOut service. Make sure to click the "Accept" button to apply the changes.



b) Test your microphone and speakers.

Go to Tools -> Options -> Audio. Click on the "Start" button next to the sentence "Test your sound device" Speak to the microphone and you will hear yourself in your speakers or headsets. This confirms that your sound has been setup correctly. Now just click on the "Stop" button to stop sound test.

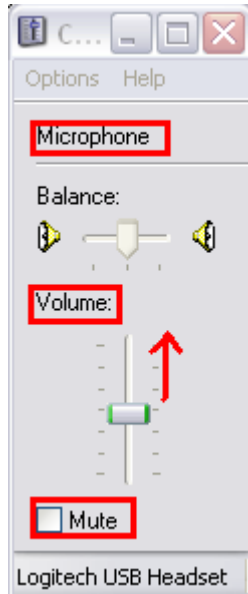


c) To quickly access your main/windows microphone slider, just click on the microphone icon located in the bottom of the Raketu program see below.

By Clicking on the microphone, the main volume controller for microphone will open.



Make sure it is not on mute and also raise the volume of the microphone slider to higher level.



d)

Make sure you did not mute the mic or the speakers. Blue icon mean the sound is **ON**



If you make the sound mute the icon will change color to gray. Gray icon means **MUTE**.

Make sure your sound devices are **ON** in Raketu program (icons must be blue). To turn it on or off, just click on the icon.



If you still have a problems with the audio in Raketu, make sure you did check audio setup in windows Vista!

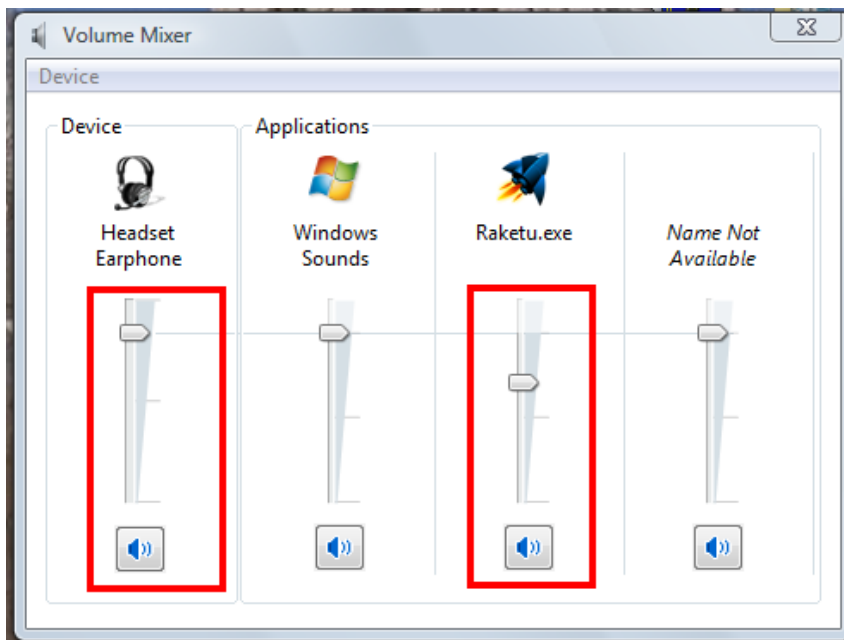
1. Right click on „speaker icon" in the system tray (right hand bottom area next to the clock on your screen) and you will get a menu.



2. Choose Open Volume Mixer from the menu.



Make sure the volume slider is on high and it is not mute.

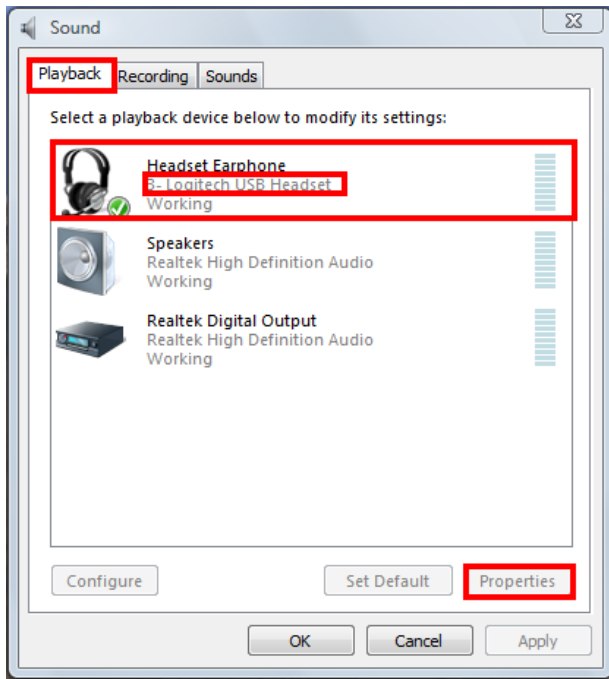


3. Choose „Playback devices“ from the menu

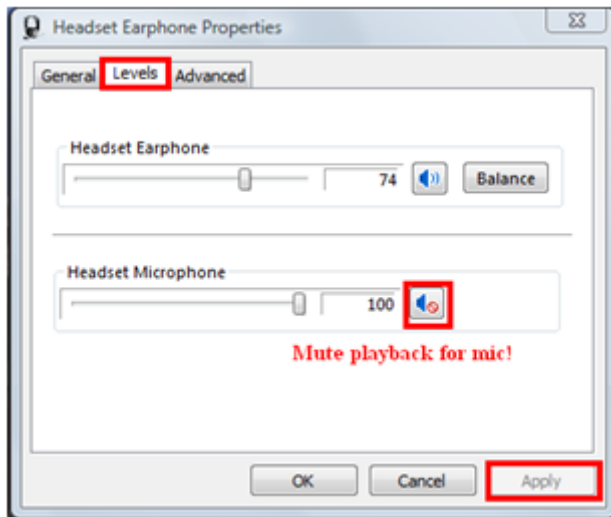


If you are experiencing an echo make sure your microphone playback is on mute!!! If you do not have it on mute, it can also create a noise while you make a call. Make sure it is on MUTE!!! Double click on the „audio device you are using“ or click on the „Properties“ to open the volume levels. See that windows picked up the correct audio device you plan to use as headsets.

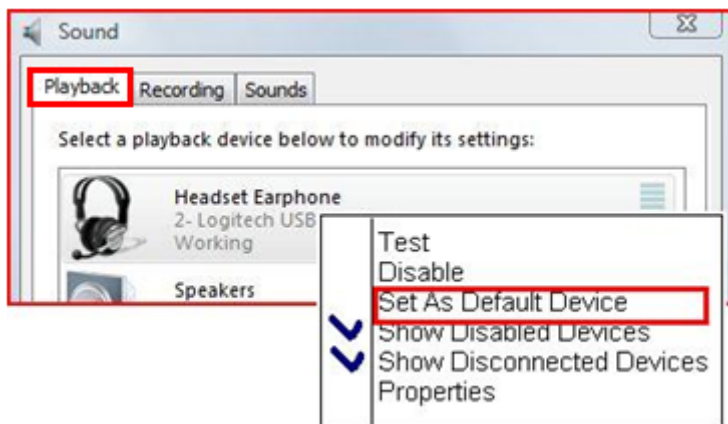
4. Now you select audio for your headsets. Make sure that the right type of heasets is selected – like Logitech USB headsets in our example.



Here make sure that the mic playback is on mute and then click on “apply”



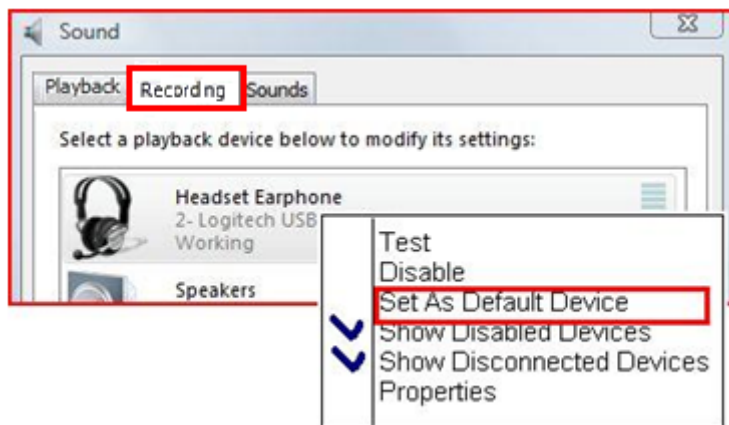
Make sure your headsets are selected as DEFAULT DEVICE in Playback Tab! Right Click on the headsets and from the menu select „Set As Default Device“. Then click on APPLY button in the bottom of the window.



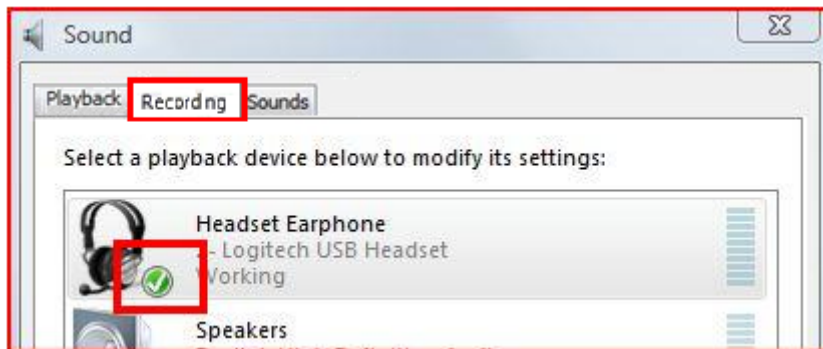
The green check mark shows that your headsets are selected as Default Device.



Make sure your headsets are selected as DEFAULT DEVICE in Recording Tab! Right Click on the headsets and from the menu select „Set As Default Device“. Then click on APPLY button in the bottom of the window.



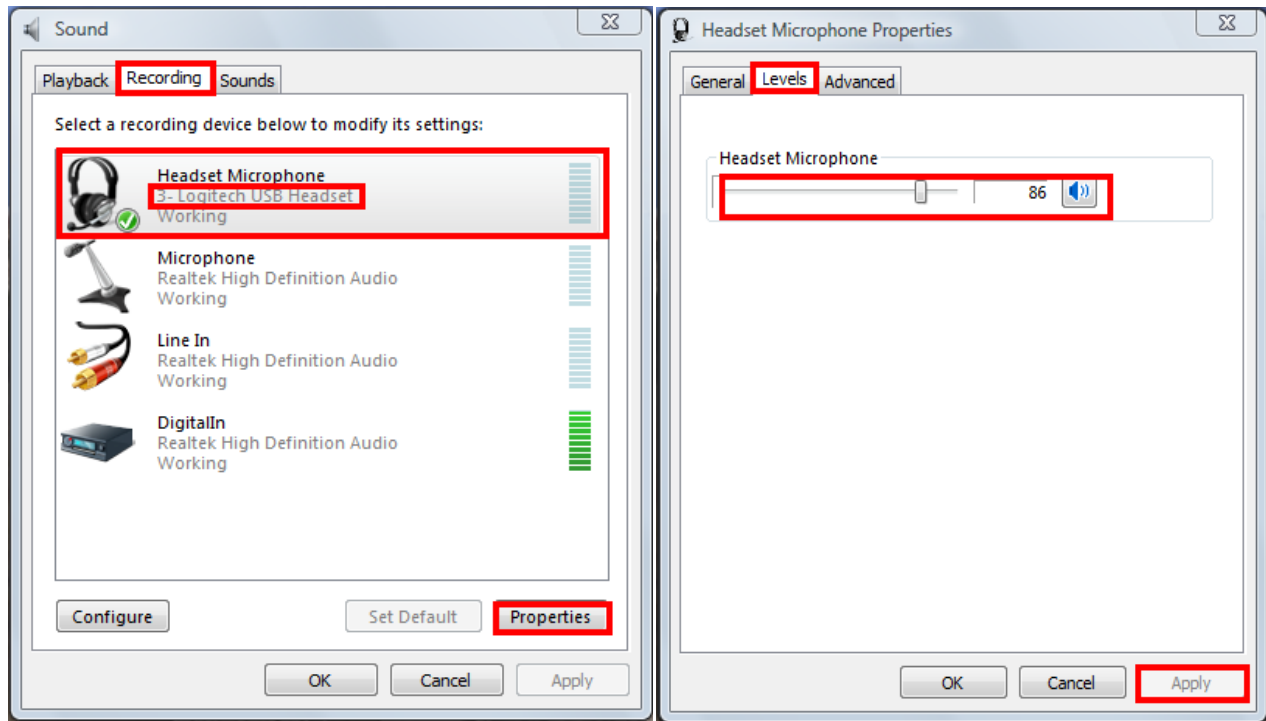
The green check mark shows that your headsets are selected as Default Device.



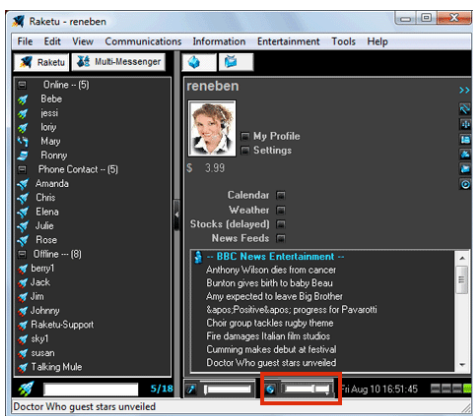
5. Choose „Recording devices“ from the menu. Check the recording device and its levels.



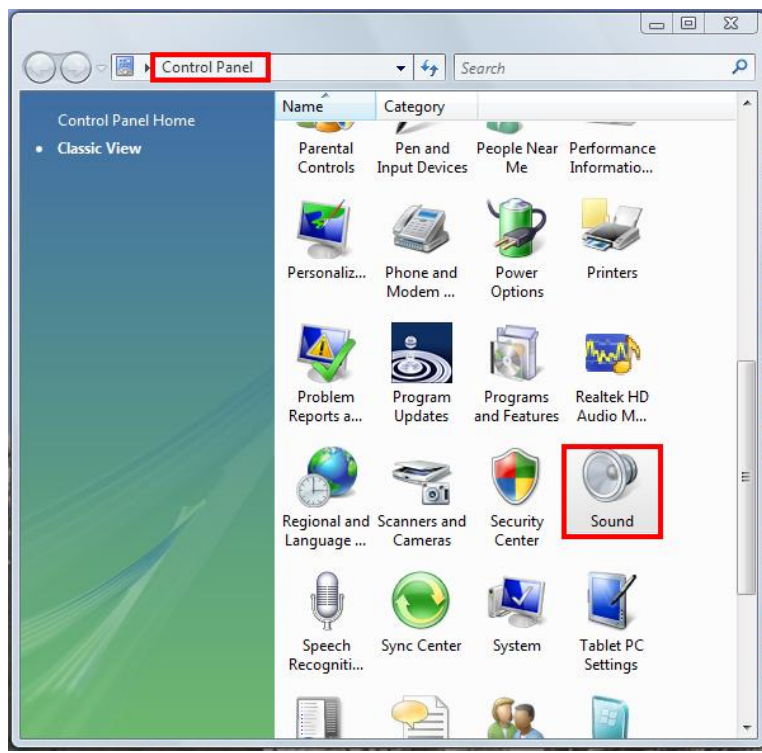
Double click on the device to get to the levels, or click on „Properties“.



6. Raketu is now set to be used with your Vista audio setup. You can adjust the volume slider for speakers .



If you do not see the “sound icon” in the system tray, you can also get to the “Recording and playback devices” setup this way: Click on START->Control Panel" -> "Sound"



To quickly access your main/windows microphone slider, just click on the microphone icon located in the bottom of the Raketu program.
